His name was Nicodemus, and he came at night to speak with Jesus. He was a member of the sect known as Pharisees and may not have wanted to be seen speaking with Jesus.

This story is found in the Book of John. The Savior did not waste words when speaking to Nicodemus, telling him right away that man must be born again (from above).

Jesus then spoke the familiar words, “For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life” (John 3:16).
